Acrostic poem for a City

In this assignment you will write an Acrostic Poem about a major city. "An acrostic poem is a type of poetry where the first, last or other letters in a line spell out a particular word or phrase. The most common and simple form of an acrostic poem is where the first letters of each line spell out the word or phrase." Below is an example.

Occasionally she gives me a treat.

Mac and cheese is a meal that can't be beat!

Now it is your turn! Write a poem about a major city in the world. You will need to do some research about the city so that you are able to list facts about the city in your poem.

Be sure that each new line starts with the next letter in the name of the city.
